The *Globe and Mail* has revealed who will evaluate this year's Canada's Young Lions submissions for the Print, Film/Cyber and Media categories. The critics, who are ad industry veterans from across Canada, will be responsible for choosing eight young media stars who will then present their work at the Cannes Lions International Festival of Creativity.

Lauren Richards, CEO, Media Experts and the *Globe's* Young Lions jury president, will moderate the nine-person Media jury. On the Print jury, which will be moderated by jury president and *MiC* executive editor Mary Maddever, are Ian MacKellar, creative director, Bensimon Byrne and Angus Tucker, co-creative director and founding partner, among others.

This year's Film and Cyber jury, also moderated by Maddever, includes Jordan Doucette, creative director, Taxi Canada and Heather Chambers, creative director, Leo Burnett.
